## What is Supported Employment?

Supported employment enables people with disabilities to find, secure and maintain paid employment in the open labour market.

On the job training and individualised long term supports are key elements of supported employment.

## The Beneficiaries of Supported Employment

**All people with disability** interested in employment in the open labour market.

**Employers** receive backup support of a professional service, they gain a valuable employee and they can introduce an equal opportunities policy within the organisation.

**The wider community** benefits through the individuals personal and monetary input into the local economy.

## The Company

IASE is a national voluntary organisation which was established in February 1994 with the aim of promoting and developing supported employment at a national Level. In 2006 IASE is the representative voice of almost 500 members in Ireland, who in turn are working with over 5,000 individuals.
